

## **TCU signs the protocol of intentions to inspect the 2014 World Cup**

The President of the Brazilian Court of Audit (TCU), Minister Ubiratan Aguiar, signed last Tuesday the protocol of intentions for articulation and support to the actions of oversight of public resources employed in the 2014 Soccer World Cup. The agreement signed between the TCU, the Chamber of Deputies, the Federal Senate, and the state and city courts of auditors from the cities chosen to host the games has the purpose of uniting efforts, developing partnerships and exchanging information to make the actions directed toward the oversight of public resources employed in the World Cup feasible.

The President highlighted the importance of acting in partnership with the control authorities. “We hope for the best championship in a country that knows how to employ its money. Citizenship shall be the keyword in this mega-event”, stated Ubiratan Aguiar.

The meeting took place in the Chamber of Deputies, and was convened by the Financial Oversight and Control Committee. The Chairman of the Committee, Sílvio Torres, highlighted that the partnership between the courts of auditors will allow a more effective inspection and more control over the public expenses.
