

## **The full Plenary of the Brazilian Court of Audit reelects the president and the vice-president for 2010**

Yesterday, the full plenary of the Brazilian Court of Audit (TCU) reelected Ministers Ubiratan Aguiar and Benjamin Zymler, respectively, for the positions of President and vice-president for the calendar year of 2010.

Minister Ubiratan Aguiar was born on the district of Cedro (CE), graduated in Social and Judicial Sciences by the Federal University of Ceara (UFCE). He worked as a congressman (1987-2001) and as a councilman (1967-1971). He is a Minister of the Brazilian Court of Audit since May, 2001.

Minister Benjamim Zymler was born in Rio de Janeiro (RJ) and holds a bachelor degree on Electric Engineering by the Military Engineering Institute (IME) and also has a degree in Law by the University of Brasilia (UnB), on the study field of Law and Government. Holds the position of Minister since September, 2001.
