

# **The 2014 World Cup Monitoring and Control Website received over 14.000 visits in less than 3 days**

More than 14.000 visitors accessed the 2014 World Cup Monitoring and Control website between the 11th and 13th of May. There were over 40 thousand accesses to the available pages in less than three days. This represented an increase of 5.478 visitors to the Brazilian Court of Audit (TCU) homepage, in the same period.

The electronic site was implemented by TCU and will be fed by the Courts of Accounts of the states and municipalities. The goal is to provide society with information on the oversight of the public money use with the World Cup. Through the website, the public will have access to monitoring documents of each stadium, ports, airports and urban mobility being developed. The public will also be able to check the news related to the 2014 World Cup monitoring and to obtain the contact of each Court of Accounts in charge of overseeing the infrastructure works. The goal is to allow the public to monitor, in a timely manner, each work development, with information on physical and financial execution and photos. Monitoring reports will be provided for each Court of Accounts in accordance with the projects development.

The oversight of the expansion and modernization of ports, airports and loans from BNDES (Brazilian Economic and Social Development Bank) and Caixa (Brazilian Federal Loan and Savings Bank) to states and municipalities will be carried out by TCU. However, the work on soccer stadiums and urban mobility renovations, such as roads widening will be inspected by the state or local Courts of Accounts, according to the resources destination.

According to TCU's President, Minister Ubiratan Aguiar, we must invest in preventive measures to avoid misuse of public money. "The success of the 2014 World Cup demands commitment from the Federal Government and the Federal District, as well as the states and municipalities that will be hosting the games. Only by turning into reality the proposals for improvements for the host cities, the country will achieve the success desired by all of us", he said.
