

The Area that Inspects Public Works will Triple its Auditing Team

The Brazilian Court of Audit (TCU) has been enhancing its team of auditors to be able to handle the increasing demand for inspections, especially in the public works area.

This year, a public contest was held to hire 88 auditors to work exclusively in the Public Works Audit Secretariat. They will take office in December. This will triple the TCU's team in this area, which currently has 35 auditors in Brasilia.

The admission of these auditors will complete an expansion process of the technical staff of that court, which began six years ago. In 2003, after the Fiscal Responsibility Law enactment, Congress approved the creation of 600 new posts for the TCU.
